



**STATEMENT OF THE PRESIDIUM OF THE BALTIC ASSEMBLY  
On Greenland and the Future of Democracy in Europe<sup>1</sup>**

We, the members of the Presidium of the Baltic Assembly, standing in solidarity with the Nordic region,

*highlight* that the Baltic States stand firmly for territorial integrity and sovereignty of Denmark, as well as are committed to developing further joint steps by the European Union to protect democracy in Europe;

*remind* that all decisions on Greenland belong exclusively to the people of Greenland and Denmark;

*emphasise* that the Baltic States and the Nordic countries continue to demonstrate unwavering unity during these challenging times, standing together in support of one another and reaffirming their shared commitment to democratic values;

*underscore* the importance of the United States and the Kingdom of Denmark being part of NATO, thus ensuring a platform for addressing challenges related to the security of Greenland and the whole Arctic region;

*call* the Member States of the European Union to uphold unity in position and action, supported by consistent communication and ongoing direct dialogue with the United States, while maintaining unwavering support and consistent focus on Ukraine.
