



**STATEMENT OF THE PRESIDIUM OF THE BALTIC ASSEMBLY
On Russia's Ongoing War of Aggression against Ukraine and
International Attempts to End It**

We, the members of the Presidium of the Baltic Assembly, standing in support of Ukraine and its sovereignty and territorial integrity,

highlight that Russia's ongoing war of aggression against Ukraine continues to present a serious challenge to European security;

underline the importance of sustained European unity in supporting Ukraine and in efforts to bring the aggression to an end;

calling for a coherent European approach that is essential to maintaining security and upholding Europe's core principles;

emphasise that meaningful negotiations cannot take place while Russian missile and drone attacks against Ukraine continue; therefore, a comprehensive and verifiable ceasefire is a necessary precondition for any credible diplomatic process;

stress that any peace process must be conducted in accordance with international law and with Ukraine's full consent.
